

# Reading Frederick Douglas - Together - Together Hyde Park!!

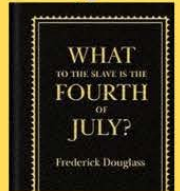
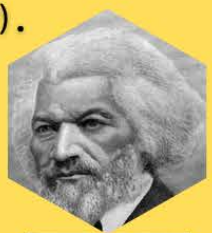
